Do you like to camp? Do you like to travel? Well, we have a great opportunity for you to do both! Come join us at the Scottish International Patrol Jamborette in Scotland. Our plans are to leave Saturday 14 July 2012 and returning Saturday 4 August with three days pre jamborette traveling around Edinburgh. The jamborette starts Tuesday 17 July for 10 days then off you go to stay at a Scottish Scout's house for 5 days before we meet as a full group again and explore Glasgow before our return to America. We will stay at a scout hall pre and post jamborette and travel by train, bus and maybe subway and ferry. We will do almost anything that the group plans for such as the castle in Edinburgh, and museums. We will meet as a group every other month starting in January until we leave.



We have space for 12 male and/or female youth and 2 adults that are registered with BSA. Scout ages are 13 through and including 17 years of age by 27 July 2012. The two adult participants will be the Longhouse Council Contingent Leaders for the 2012 Contingent.

While at camp you will stay patrol style with a Scottish patrol and participate in a variety of events and activities including: traveling into town, bike riding, cooking, having races, building a floatable boat and going down the River Tay on it. There will be three campfires and time to meet and make new friends from about 20 countries including Scotland, Russia, Netherlands, Austria, New Zealand, Ireland, Canada and many others.

A non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 is required by December 12, 2011 and the final cost is expected to be about \$2500.00 depending on costs of airfare and the value of the US Dollar. The \$2500.00 includes the jamborette fees and meals, airfare, ground transportation to jamborette site, activity fees. NOT included is your own spending money, extra baggage fees, passport fees, some meals and medical physical fees.
