This course is designed to help leaders master the basic camping skills required for Tenderfoot through First Class and how a Boy Scout Troop works. **This course will be held at Camp Woodland on Friday from 5:30 PM to Sunday at 4:00 PM.**

Experienced Scout Leaders will serve as instructors and will help you learn how to set up camp, cook, work with woods tools and ropes, first aid, planning campfire programs, map and compass skills, etc. Also covered will be the components of a troop and how they function.

Each Session will bring to life the pages of the *Boy Scout Handbook* to help you deliver the promise of Scouting to yourself and the youth you serve. It will increase your comfort level and give you confidence as a trained, skilled leader. The program will also give you the opportunity to work with other Scout Leaders from you area, make new friends and reinforce skill techniques with fellow unit leaders.

To be “**Trained**” in their positions, Adult Boy Scout leaders need to have completed all three segments of the basic training continuum; **New Leader Essentials, Boy Scout Leader Specific Training and Introduction to Outdoor Skills**. This course fulfills all three requirements. **New Leader Essentials**, which will be presented Sunday afternoon, following the **Boy Scout Leader Specific** and **Introduction to Outdoor Skills** segments.
