DISABILITY AWARENESS

The theme is disability awareness and it is our hope to help Scouts and Scouters become more aware of many of the disabilities we all encounter and how to best support people with special needs so that can enjoy Scouting to its fullest. Many of us know one or more people that have special challenges that we wish we knew more about and how to appropriately work with these folks. Throughout this Camporee we are hoping that everyone will get a chance to experience what it might be like to have a specific disability and the challenges it creates; how to help youth and adults that might have a disability; and to find ways to help youth and adults with disabilities have successful Scouting experiences.

Although many of the requirements for the Disability Awareness merit badge will be covered, a youth cannot complete the badge at the Camporee (unless they do prior work ahead of times). We are hoping to have some local agencies at the Camporee to talk about what they do and how they can help. This would be a great opportunity, for those that want to complete the merit badge, for youth to talk to an agency and see how they can complete the merit badge.

- Location: Palermo Town Park - County Route 45 - 1 mile west of Route 3
- Cost: \$7.00 per person
- Campsites: Please check in at headquarters upon arrival prior to setting up camp. Sites may be assigned. Depending on ground conditions, all vehicles (including Troop trailers) may be restricted to designated parking areas.
- Utilities: Water: there is limited access, please bring your own.
Fires: NO ground fires, please bring your own fire wood.
Trash: this is a carry-in/carry-out park.
Rest Rooms: Port-a-Johns will be available.
- Program: The program will consist of various events to challenge the Scouts to perform certain tasks as if they had particular disabilities. There will also be various displays set up providing information from various organizations to aide individuals with disabilities. Information on Scouts with Disabilities and the alternate requirements for Eagle Scout will be available. See the schedule attached.
