- A BSA Tour Plan must be filed with your reservation and at least 2 weeks prior to your stay.
- Any damage to any facilities used will result in the unit or group paying for the full repair or replacement. This will be determined by the Program Director and or Camp Ranger.
- The unit leader in charge must sign in prior to unloading. The unit leader must sign out upon departure.
- No Food in tents and all food must be stored and locked in your troop trailer.
- No pets, alcohol, personal firearms, fireworks, motorized bikes or all-terrain vehicles, watercraft or personal bicycles are permitted on Camp property during the fall camping season.
- Speed limit is 10 mph in camp.
- Only 1 vehicle per unit is allowed in the camp site. The rest must be parked in the main parking lot.
- Please clean facilities used and leave it better than you found it. Pack in and pack out all trash.
- All youth protection concerns must be reported to the Camp Ranger immediately.
- The Buddy System must be in effect during the entire stay on the Property.
- Graves Mountain is not accessible outside of the Sabattis Scout Reservation Summer Camp Season.
- All Areas outside of the SSR Fall Camping Season Map is Off Limits as a safety precaution during hunting season.
