This year the Old Goat Society of Onondaga District at its Spring Camporee is honoring 'Hobie Newton, Old Goat #14, who turned 99 in October 2017. 'Hobie has served many years as a Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster. He is currently registered with Troop 22 in DeWitt.

The "Old Goats" were started by one boy calling his beloved Scoutmaster by this nickname. A few years later after that boy grew up, Onondaga District adopted the name to honor Scouters who gave a little extra to the district. They did not always have to be OLD and they soon added women, Nanny Goats, to their ranks. We are 53 years old this year and want to give the boys a super fun experience. The event is at The Lafayette Apple Festival grounds, located west on Route 20 off Route 81, Exit 15. You will be entering at the Route 20 driveway.

We have gathered various activities and contests for both Boys Scouts and Cubs that have been presented at Camporees over the years. Goat cart races, Flint and Steel Fire Building, Orienteering, Disability Awareness, and many other activities. There will be a First Aid station, but minor injuries should be handled at the troop site. For accidents of a more serious nature, send the injured (with an adult) to the first aid station located at the information booth. Remember to bring medical release forms.

We will have a Trading Post with some old patches, pins, and other items for sale as well as snack items.

## **Judged Contests for Boy Scouts Only:**

### **Patrol Flags Rules**

- Flags will be judged on originality, Old Goat theme and detail.
- The top 3 winners will be awarded a patch.

### **Goat Cart Appearance and Race Rules**

- Carts should have 2 wheels and big enough to carry ONE person.
- It needs to be pulled and NOT pushed.
- Races will be one-on-one, timed; and the top 3 fastest times will be winners.
- They will also be judged on appearance for originality and technicality, and whatever sparks the Old Goats.
- Patches will be awarded for both the race and the appearance separately.

### **One Pot Meal Rules**

- Using one pot, cook an entire balanced meal. It could be for Breakfast, Lunch or Dinner, but not Dessert.
- That means if you must boil, fry, or sauté it needs to be done in that pot/pan; so, plan out how to prepare it.
- The top 3 winning patrols will be awarded patches.
- The top 3 winning adults will get to “strut around the campground” and be recognized at the Campfire!

### **Activity Judging**

- Each judged contest will have a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winner.
- Each patrol participating in an activity or contest will earn a point, and the top 1-5 scores in each activity will win descending points. Those 2 numbers will be added together to get a 1st, 2nd and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner for activities.
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### **Campfire**

Each Den and Patrol will need to submit an appropriate song, skit or cheer for the Campfire.

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## Campground Rules for Old Goat VI

- You carry in/you carry out trash etc.
- **NO** ground fires, please use a fire barrel or other device
- **NO** cutting of trees. There may be some wood, bring wood if you need to cook with it
- Picnic tables are **not** available
- Water will be available, but bring some with you
- Follow the signs to dump grey water
- There will be Port-A-Johns with sanitizer.
- Stay inside police taped areas
- **Pop Warner Football fields are a restricted area.** Anyone caught in this area will be sent home with their unit.
- Stay out of buildings unless invited in. Obey the **OFF-LIMITS** signs
- **No** trailers/cars at campsites but you will be able to drive in to drop off
- Bring chairs to the campfire
- Patrols should be no larger than 8
- Please remember all the Scout rules; conduct, uniform, and safety

### **Troops and Packs should bring:**

- Wood and water for their own use
- Tables and chairs
- Paper and pens
- First Aid and Lashing skills
