Quick Facts about Packs and Cub Scouts

- The Pack meets once a month as a group, usually meet on a week night in the evening
- Dens are made up of boys or girls of the same grade and rank. Dens usually meet 1-3 times each month to work on requirements, take trips or do service projects.
- The Pack goes camping at least once each year. Cub Scout camping is "family camping", where all family members are welcome to attend. It's a great way to learn about camping!
- Training is required for all adult Leaders, and is provided by both the Pack and the Boy Scouts of America Council office.
