



## 2019 Sabattis Scout Reservation CIT Application

### General Requirements

Sabattis offers a Counselor in Training (CIT) program for Boy Scouts who will be 14 years of age by the start of staff week. Applicants must be First Class or registered with an active Explorer Post or Venture Crew.

During your session as a CIT you will experience assignments in all areas of camp operation. You must first complete a training program. Preference in selecting camp staff for future years will be determined by successful completion of your training and the CIT experience.

As you consider this opportunity, you and your parents should be aware that your pay would be the training you receive. Your room and board will be provided to you, along with Health and Accident insurance at no cost.

The CIT program encourages Scouts to attend Summer Camp with their unit. In order to do this we offer two, three-week sessions in addition to staff week. Staff Week is mandatory for all staff members including CIT's. (6/29/19-8/8/19)

As a CIT you will follow the rules and regulations of the camp at all times. These rules and regulations are defined in the staff manual that you will receive. If you are selected for this program and do not live up to the standard you will be asked to leave the program by the Camp Director.
