<u>Program</u>

The idea of the camporee is to provide an opportunity for Scouts to practice good hiking and backpacking.

Patrols will hike throughout camp from one station to the next carring any materials that they need.

There will be staggered starts for the patrols – scheduled presently about 15 minutes apart starting at 9:00 AM on Saturday. Patrols must report 15 minutes before their scheduled departure time. Patrols/Troops will be allowed to select their departure time based on the order of registration – first registered gets first choice of starting time., etc.

Along the trail, patrols will take part in activities on basic Scout skills. Scouts should bring all of the water with them that will need on the hike. There may be no safe water sources along the way. Patrols should stop at noon wherever they happen to be and have their lunch. It will be a twenty-minute lunch break.

Patrols should have the following with them:

- At least one compass per patrol
- One first aid kit
- A personal first aid kit per Scout
- A patrol flag
- One six or eight-foot length of rope per scout.
- A small notebook and pen/pencil

Guidelines and Notes

Check-in

All patrols must check in 15 minutes prior to their assigned starting time. They should be ready to go at that time. They should also have their patrol flag with them.

<u>Parking</u>

We ask that all vehicles stay in the main camp parking lot throughout the event.

<u>Water</u>

Water and other drinks for the hike must be brought with them on the hike. Troops should bring an initial amount of water with them. There may be additional water sources available while on the trail, but they should not be relied upon.

<u>Trash</u>

Units are required to take all trash with them, along the trail and throughout the camp. Leave No Trace rules are to be strictly adhered to.

Bugs!!

The hike will take you through a variety of ecosystems. Be prepared for bugs – and be sure to perform tick checks throughout the hike!
