The Longhouse Council, BSA invites you to participate in **Scoutmaster Leader Specific, Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills**. This course is designed to help leaders master the basic camping skills required for Tenderfoot through First Class and how a Boy Scout Troop works.

Scoutmaster Leader Specific Module 1 and 2, will be held on March 31st at Jordan Community Center at 5 Rt 31 Jordan, NY 8:30 am- 4:00 pm, and Module 3 of Scoutmaster Specific and the Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills course will be held at Camp Woodland on Friday from 5:30 PM to Sunday at 4:00 PM.

Experienced Scout Leaders will serve as instructors and will help you learn how to set up camp, cook, work with woods tools and ropes, first aid, planning campfire programs, map and compass skills, etc. Also covered will be the components of a troop and how they function.

Each Session will bring to life the pages of the Boy Scout Leader Handbook to help you deliver the promise of Scouting to yourself and the youth you serve. It will increase your comfort level and give you confidence as a trained, skilled leader. The program will also give you the opportunity to work with other Scout Leaders from your area, make new friends and reinforce skill techniques with fellow unit leaders.



To be "Trained" in their positions, Adult Boy Scout leaders need to have completed the basic training continuum; Youth Protection Guidelines Training, This is Scouting (both found online at MyScouting.org), Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training, and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.
