1 -- BSA Lifeguard is a professional lifeguard certification. Participants must be 15+ years old. Participants must have current American Red Cross First Aid and American Red Cross CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer or equivalent or obtain these certification within 120 days of the start of class to receive BSA Lifeguard certification. Course generally run all day, every day.

* -- An asterisk indicates that this badge requires one or more pre-requisites before camp to be completed. Refer to the pre-requisite information sheet for details on individual badges. If these pre-requisites are not completed, the Scout can receive a partial on the merit badge.

\$ -- A dollar sign indicates that a merit badge has an additional program fee that must be paid at the camp Trading Post to participate in the badge or materials for crafts need to be purchased at the trading post.

2 -- Significant additional out-of-class time during open periods will be needed to complete badge.

3 -- We will only complete requirement 3 (Build, launch, and recover a model rocket). This shouldn't take a Scout the entire week during this period.

4 -- Must be enrolled in Small Boat Sailing or be able to demonstrate general sailing competency; or be accompanied by a person with such competency.
