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Sessions:

- ❖ **Incident Reporting** – Keeping our scouts safe is a priority. Reporting incidents in a timely manner is vital to tracking the root causes of unsafe conditions. This session focuses on the incident reporting process. Anyone responsible for camping and other activities should be familiar with the system.
- ❖ **Event Security and Safety** – Hear from those that have provided event security and safety for events like camporees, fun days and other larger events.
- ❖ **Diversity and Inclusion** - Join us for a presentation and Q&A with GNYC's Diversity Chair and Board Member, Antonio del Rosario, on how to build training and a Diversity Committee that helps your districts and units be more inclusive and equitable as well as facilitating the new merit badge, Citizenship in Society. Antonio, an Eagle Scout and Scoutmaster, is a trained expert from NYU and Cornell's Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Belonging (DEIB) program.
- ❖ **Membership** – Councils share their Membership Plan Status. Share membership recruiting, retention, and planning recruitment events ideas from other Councils in NST-10. If this is your first time preparing this plan, learn from your counterparts.
- ❖ **Membership** – Councils share their Best Membership Practices From 2022. This is a great session to pick up some tips and new ideas.
- ❖ **New Presidents and Executive VP Orientation** – This session will guide a new council president/chair or an executive vice president/chair in what they need to focus on in this important role.
